



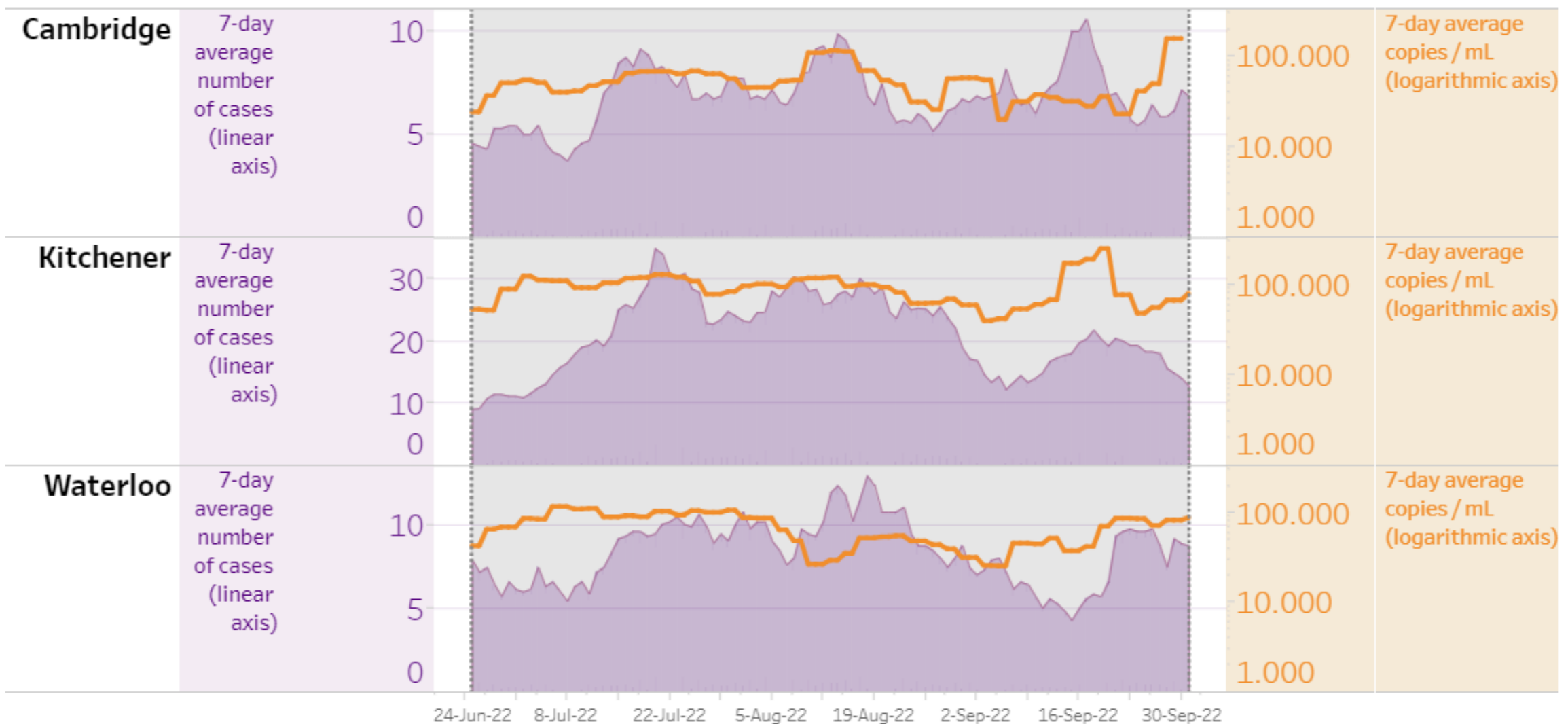

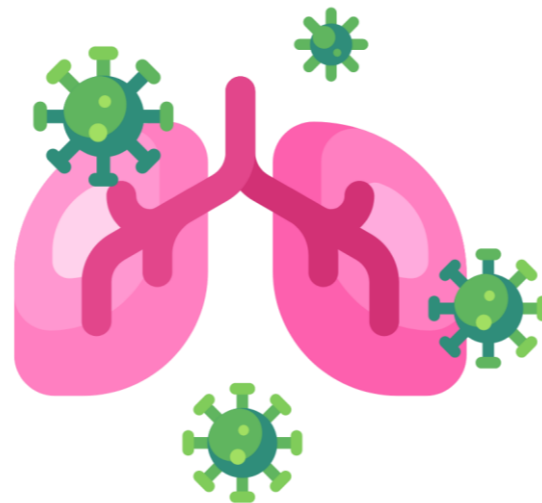

- As of Saturday, October 8 there have been 5 cases of Influenza reported in Waterloo Region
- Flu vaccine will be available soon for the general public (ages 6 months and older).

### Cumulative Laboratory-Confirmed Influenza Case Counts

**116 cases**

Number of influenza cases reported to date in Ontario for the 2022-23 season:

**Total influenza: 116**

**Influenza A: 113**

**Influenza B: 3**

### Overall Assessment

**Influenza A activity: Low**

**Influenza B activity: Low**

Influenza activity in Ontario for Week 39 was similar when compared to Week 38.
