BILL 23 – INCLUSIONARY ZONING

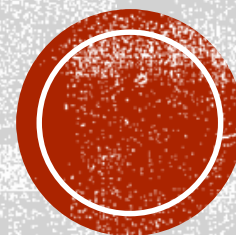
- *“This legislation supports regulatory changes to provide certainty regarding inclusionary zoning rules, with a maximum 25-year affordability period, a five per cent cap on the number of inclusionary zoning units, and a standardized approach to determining the price or rent of an affordable unit under an inclusionary zoning program” (Bill 23).*
