**Re: Blue Box Transition Update** 

### **Background:**

In 2021, the Ontario government passed <u>a new regulation</u> that shifts the financial and operational responsibility of blue box recycling programs away from municipalities and to the producers, those companies that produce the blue box material and packaging waste. All Ontario municipalities are required to move towards this new business model by December 31, 2025.

The Producers are also fully responsible for all customer service issues, ongoing education and providing recycling containers to the residents.

# Who is looking after the recycling program?

<u>Circular Materials</u> (a Producer-controlled non-profit organization) has assumed responsibility for operating the collection and receiving of blue box materials across Ontario. It will also handle all post-collection management for most of the blue box material in the province. The timeframe for Producers to begin managing the recycling program occurs over a number of years. Waterloo Region will transition on March 2, 2024.

Circular Materials has recently awarded the current contractors (<u>Miller Waste Systems</u> and <u>Emterra Environmental</u>) in Waterloo Region as recycling service providers during the transition period only (March 2, 2024 to December 31, 2025).

All other curbside services (garbage, bulky item, organics, and yard waste) remain the responsibility of the Region of Waterloo.

#### What stays the same?

Residents should not see any change to the existing recycling program during the transition period including what material is collected, how to sort the material or their collection day.

#### What changes?
