

Appendix A - Ontario Seniors Dental Care Program capital project dental clinics in Waterloo Region

Completed capital project dental clinics:

By January 2022, both Ontario Seniors Dental Care Program capital projects at Langs Community Health Centre and Community Healthcaring Kitchener Waterloo (formerly Kitchener Downtown Community Health Center), have been completed.

Langs' capital project dental clinic includes:

- Two dental operatory rooms
- One reception/waiting area
- One panoramic x-ray room
- One sterilization room and equipment room
- One office space for use by dental staff
- Staffing includes full time dentist, one full time dental hygienist, one full time clinical dental assistant, and one full time administrative dental assistant

Community Healthcaring Kitchener-Waterloo's capital project dental clinic includes:

- Two dental operatory rooms
- One reception/waiting area
- One panoramic x-ray room
- One sterilization room and equipment room
- One office space for use by dental staff
- Staffing includes one full time dentist, one full time dental hygienist, one full time clinical dental assistant, and one full time administrative dental assistant

Wellesley capital project dental clinic (opening April 2024):

In May of 2022, the Ministry of Health approved \$583.8K for the Wellesley capital project dental clinic (\$113.6K by March 31, 2023 and remaining \$470.2K by March 31, 2024). The plans, close to completion, include:

- One dental operatory room
- One common/shared reception/waiting area
- One sterilization room and equipment room
- One common/shared office space for use by dental staff
- Staffing will include one part time dentist, one part time dental hygienist, one full time clinical/administrative dental assistant
